

Metropolitan Transportation Commission
Draft Plan Bay Area – Notice of Open Houses

Interested persons are invited by the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) and the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) to comment on *Draft Plan Bay Area 2040*. Plan Bay Area 2040 is a state-mandated, integrated long-range transportation and land use plan. As required by Senate Bill 375, all metropolitan regions in California must complete a Sustainable Communities Strategy (SCS) as part of their Regional Transportation Plan (RTP). In the Bay Area, MTC and ABAG are jointly responsible for developing and adopting a SCS that integrates transportation, land use and housing to meet greenhouse gas reduction targets set by the California Air Resources Board (CARB).

A Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) prepared on *Draft Plan Bay Area 2040* is subject to public review pursuant to a separate notice.

After considering public comment, MTC and ABAG are currently scheduled to adopt *Draft Plan Bay Area 2040* at a joint meeting to be held in June 2017.
